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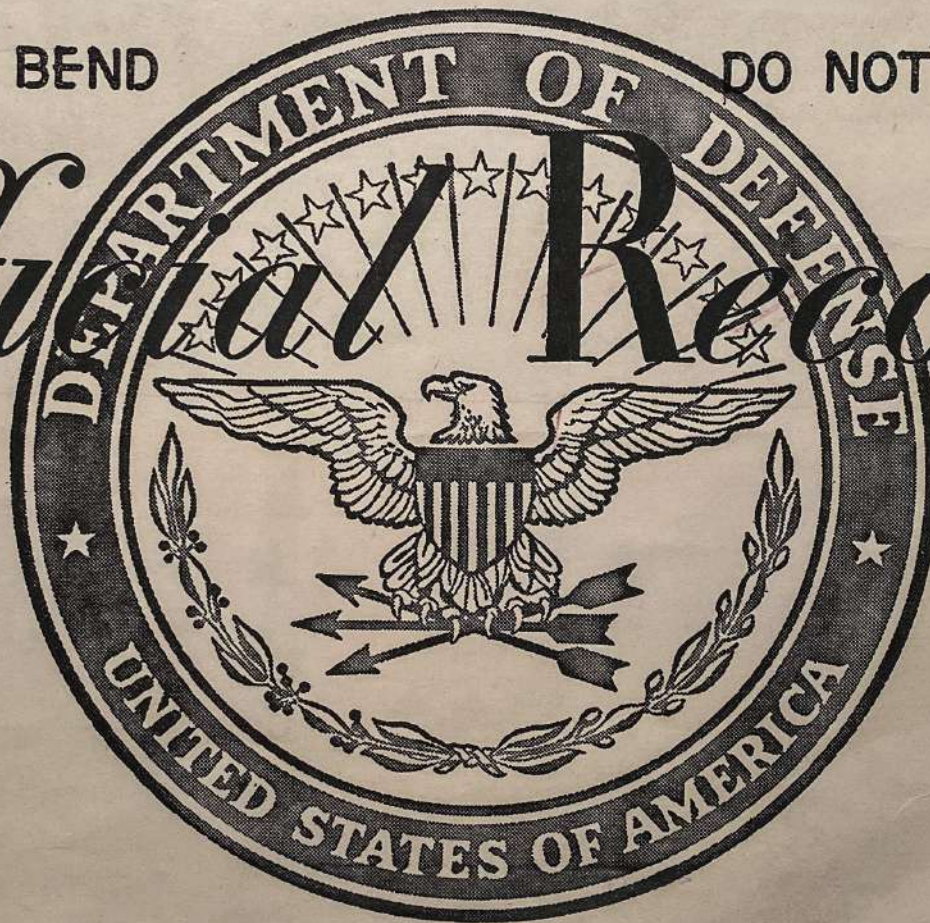

IMPORTANT NOTICE

If you have had previous military service, bring your service records with you. If you wear glasses, bring them with you.

This Local Board will furnish transportation to the induction station where you will be examined, and, if accepted for service, you will then be inducted into a branch of the Armed Forces. If you are not accepted, return transportation will be provided.

Persons reporting to the induction station in some instances are found to have developed disqualifying defects since being examined and may be rejected for these or other reasons. It is well to keep this in mind in arranging your affairs, to prevent any undue hardship if you are rejected at the induction station. If you are employed, you should advise your employer of this notice and of the possibility that you may not be accepted at the induction station. Your employer can then be prepared to replace you if you are accepted, or to continue your employment if you are rejected.

Willful failure to report promptly to this Local Board at the place specified above and at the hour and on the day named in this Order is a violation of the Universal Military Training and Service Act, as amended, and subjects the violator to fine and imprisonment. You must keep this form and bring it with you when you report to the Local Board. Bring with you sufficient clothing for 3 days.

✓ If you are so far removed from your own Local Board that reporting in compliance with this Order will be a serious hardship and you desire to report to a Local Board in the area in which you are now located, go immediately to that Local Board and make written request for transfer of your delivery for induction, taking this Order with you.



3. Reserve Obligation. a. An individual (hereafter referred to as a 5 year reservist) who was enlisted or inducted between 25 June 1948 and 19 June 1951, both dates inclusive, and prior to attaining the 26th anniversary of the date of his birth, and who serves for a period of less than 3 years in the Armed Forces, shall thereafter be transferred to a reserve component for a period of 5 years. Any such person having completed at least 21 months of active service, who thereafter satisfactorily serves in an organized unit of a reserve component for a period of at least 3 years shall, except in time of war or national emergency, be relieved of any further reserve obligation. (Sec. 4(d) (1), Universal Military Training and Service Act, as amended).

b. An individual (hereafter referred to as a 6 year reservist) who enlisted in the Regular Army for 1 year under Section 4(g), Universal Military Training and Service Act, as amended (Sec 4(g) repealed 19 June 1951, and upon termination of a period of enlistment was transferred to the Enlisted Reserve Corps for 6 years may, except in time of war or national emergency, by membership in an organized unit or by satisfactory service therein, or in an officer's training program for 4 years, be relieved of any further Reserve obligation. An individual who was initially enlisted, or appointed, or was inducted subsequent to 19 June 1951 while under 26 years of age shall, upon release from active duty be transferred to a reserve component for a period which, together with the period served on active duty subsequent to his enlistment or induction shall equal a total of 8 years. d. A member of the National Guard of the United States or of the Army Reserve who has Reserve obligation and is ordered into the Active Military Service under Section 21, Universal Military Training & Service Act, as amended, or other provision of the law, who is released from active duty prior to completion of the Service required of him under the applicable subsection (1), (2) or (3) of section 5(d) of that act will be returned to active Reserve status in a Reserve component to complete the period of Service for which he is obligated.


e. Failure to fulfill all or any part of a Reserve obligation may result in trial, in any District Court of the United States for violation of the Universal Military Training and Service Act, as amended.

f. Participation in the Reserve programs outlined above shall not prevent any person, while in a reserve component from being ordered to active duty pursuant to any provisions of law.

4. Each individual transferred to or returned to active Reserve status in a Reserve component under the provisions of the above reference legislation must report to the Chief of the Military District, or, if a National Guardsman to the Adjutant General of his state of residence within 10 days after separation from active duty as directed in paragraph 2, and thereafter must report any change of address in accordance with paragraph 6, or as otherwise instructed by the Chief of the Military District or the State Adjutant General.

5. A 5 or 6 year reservist who serves a part of his obligation in an organized unit of a reserve component or in an officers' training program and the remainder of his obligation in other than organized unit of a reserve component or in an Officers' training program will accrue credit for each type of service under an established system of point credits. Information regarding this credit system may be obtained from the Chief of your Military District or Unit Commanders

6. Pending your assignment to an organized unit of the Army Reserve (including officers training program) or enlistment in a federally recognized unit or the National guard, you will report any changes in your home address to the Chief of the Military District of the State which you indicated as your last address, including address for further reference item 47 on your report of Separation from the Armed Forces of the United States. 3. Should you desire active duty training, or enrollment in Army Extension Courses, the appropriate forms will be mailed you upon receipt of a postal card or letter request at this office.



SUBJECT: Transfer to the Standby Reserve (Excess to Needs of Ready Reserve)

TO: Each Reservist Concerned

1. The Reserve Forces Act of 1955 limits the strength of the Ready Reserve on and after 1 July 1957 to that actually needed for immediate recall to active duty in the event of war or National emergency. The Ready Reserve is composed only of participating Reservists and a limited number of Active Army Reinforcements.
2. In order to meet the ceiling strength set forth for the Ready Reserve, it is necessary that you be transferred to the Standby Reserve, since no requirement exists in the Ready Reserve for personnel of your grade and branch. Attached as Inclosure 1 is a copy of the orders effecting your transfer to the Standby Reserve. You may elect to return to Ready Reserve status by volunteering for a unit assignment in either the National Guard or USAR; and you may be returned involuntarily to the Ready Reserve if the need for your grade and branch arises and your Ready Reserve obligation has not expired.
3. Actually, there is only one change in your status, which is that in the event of war or National emergency, your availability for recall will be determined by the Selective Service System rather than by military authority. Within a short period of time, you will receive from the Selective Service System a form which you must complete. The information which you reflect on that form will be utilized by the Selective Service System to determine your eligibility for recall in the event of war or National emergency.
4. In the event that you are a nonobligated Reservist (i.e., you have completed your period of military service obligation under the UMI&S Act, as amended) it will be necessary for you to earn 20 retirement points each year if an enlisted man, and 27 retirement points if an officer, in order to be retained in the Active Reserve. In the event that you are a commissioned or warrant officer, it is mandatory that you be considered for promotion when eligible, the same as if you were in the Ready Reserve. Even though you have been found excess to the needs of the Ready Reserve, you are encouraged to participate in Reserve training; and, if you have no remaining service obligation, it is mandatory that you participate in Reserve training as stated above.

1. Your military records have recently been received by this headquarters due to the fact that you have completed your period of active honorable service. The remainder of your obligated term of service with the United States Army Reserve will be under the jurisdiction of the Idaho Military District, unless you choose to be transferred to the Idaho National Guard to serve with a National Guard unit.


2. The primary objective of the Department of the Army is to assure that quotas of trained personnel are available for recall to active duty during the early phases of mobilization. In keeping with this objective, you have been selected for an Emergency Reinforcement Designation as indicated by the inclosed order. This designation is for a period of three years and identifies you as one of the individuals that will be recalled with the designated unit in the event of mobilization.

3. Your designation to this unit was made after a review of your records which indicate that you have received training and have been awarded a Military Occupational Specialty for which the unit will have an immediate need in the event of mobilization. This designation does not impose upon you the obligation of training with the unit, however, to enable you to keep abreast of ever changing procedures and policies and to enable you to be better qualified to perform your duties in the event of mobilization, it is strongly recommended that you consider becoming active with the unit of designation or with another unit located in the immediate vicinity. In addition to the knowledge to be gained through active participation, you may receive a full day's base pay for every two-hour meeting attended as a member of a unit, and earn credits toward eventual retirement with pay.

4. You may secure assistance or information concerning active participation in the Reserve or enlistment or appointment in the National Guard from the unit commander or unit advisor of the unit to which your designation has been made.

SUBJECT: Period of Alert for Active Duty for Members of the Army Reserve

TO: Reservist Concerned

1. It is the Department of the Army policy to give members of the reserve components the maximum period of time between the date they are alerted for active duty in the event of mobilization, and the date on which they are required to enter upon active duty. The amount of alert time which can be allowed will be determined by military conditions at the time of the emergency. When military conditions permit, a 30 day or longer alert will be given.

2. The nature of future national emergencies cannot be predicted. They may or may not in all cases allow for a 30 day or longer alert period. Therefore, under appropriate circumstances, reservists are subject to entry on active duty with no advance warning or with considerably less than the otherwise intended 30 day alert. In view of the foregoing, your personal affairs should be arranged in such a manner that entry upon active duty with a short notice will cause the minimum of inconvenience and discomfort to your family, and will have the least impact on your business affairs.

Welcome Home! You have just returned from active duty and the completion of a job for which the United States Army and your country are justifiably proud. You have completed the active duty portion of your military obligation and there remains only the Reserve time which you must put in to entirely fulfill this obligation.


As you no doubt know, under the Universal Military Training and Service Act, a person who was inducted on or prior to 19 June 1951 incurred a five (5) year Reserve obligation upon release from active duty, and a person who entered the military service after 19 June 1951 incurred an eight (8) year military service obligation upon entrance on active duty. This means that when you are released from active duty, you are automatically assigned to the Army Reserve. Your records have been received from the separation center, and you have been assigned temporarily to the 6132 USAR Control Group (Reinforcement) Idaho within the "Ready Reserve" category. All Reservists within this category are in "Active Status." You are obligated for fifteen (15) days active duty training each year, and in the event of a national emergency, declared by the President or Congress of the United States, are subject to recall to active duty as an individual.

You may, however, by being assigned to a United States Army Reserve or National Guard Unit satisfy a five (5) year obligation in three (3) years, or if you have an eight (8) year obligation, become eligible for transfer to the "Standby Reserve" for the remainder of your obligation, and be subject to recall in the event of a national emergency declared by Congress. Members of the Standby Reserve are in "Active Status" and may be required to perform fifteen (15) days active duty each year.

Members of Army Reserve units attend regularly scheduled paid training assemblies and fifteen (15) days of active duty each year. They are also subject to recall to active duty only with their unit.

The inclosed post card is directed to this headquarters. If you desire training with either the Army Reserve or National Guard unit nearest your home, it is requested that you sign and mail the card giving your service number, grade and return address.
